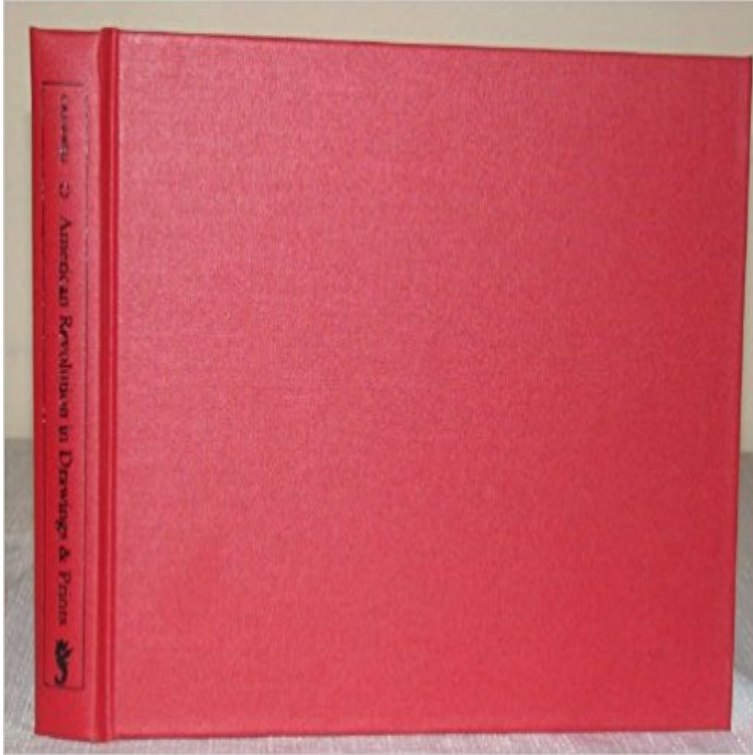


The American Revolution in Drawings and Prints: a Checklist of 1765...
