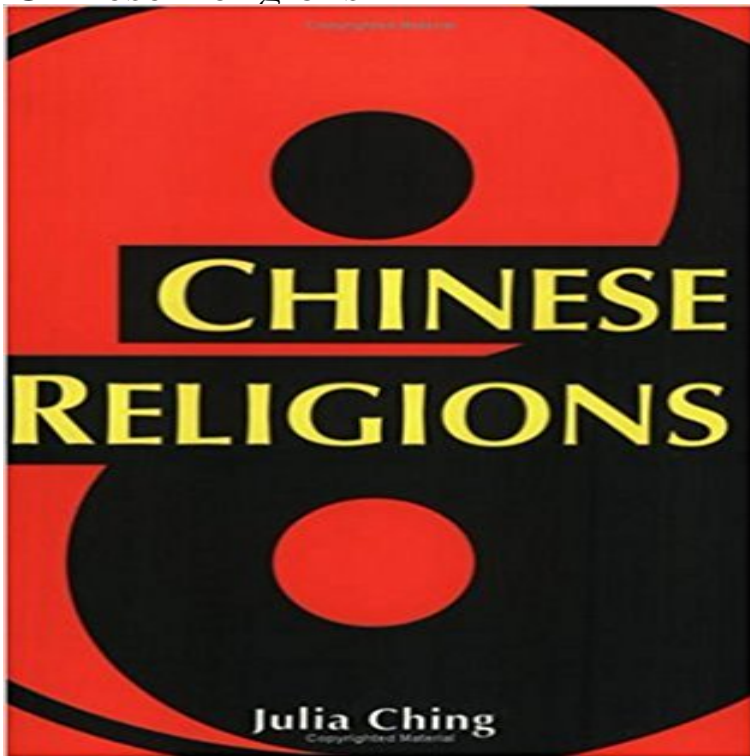


# Chinese Religions
